

Co-curricular and Non-curricular Activity Program

The board recognizes that the educational goals and objectives of the district can best be achieved by providing a broad offering of purposeful learning experiences and activities, including co-curricular and non-curricular programs. Such curriculum-related and non-curriculum-related activities shall ordinarily be conducted wholly or partly outside the regular school day and shall be non-discriminatory and available to all students who voluntarily elect to participate.

The co-curricular program encompasses approved curriculum-related activities.

Non-curriculum related programs do not directly relate to district approved courses and curriculum.

The superintendent approves all co-curriculum activities included within the associated student body (ASB) program. The principal, or principal designee, is authorized to approve:

1. Co-curriculum-related activities that are not part of the associated student body program.
2. Non-curriculum-related activities that are both part of and not part of the associated student body program.

The principal or designee shall make facilities available for both co-curricular and non-curricular activities and designate staff members to support and supervise them.
