

School-Support Organizations

The Board of Directors recognizes the importance of a parent-teacher organization at each school building for the purpose of providing an opportunity through which parents, teachers, and students may unite their efforts and interests to enhance the school program.

Booster clubs and/or special interest organizations may be formed to support and strengthen specific activities conducted within the school or district. All such groups must receive the approval of the school principal or superintendent in order to be recognized as a booster organization. Staff participation, cooperation, and support are encouraged in such recognized organizations.

The superintendent shall establish procedures for the conduct of parent-teacher organizations, booster clubs, and other special interest organizations.
