

Eliminating Tobacco and Alcohol on School Premises

The Board of Directors, cognizant of the harmful effects of all types of tobacco and alcohol use, is committed to establishing a tobacco and alcohol-free learning and working environment. In order that this commitment may be met, all tobacco and alcohol use in or on district premises is strictly prohibited.

This prohibition extends to all students enrolled in the district's schools, all persons employed by the district, and all other persons who, for whatever reason and at whatever time, enter or come upon district premises. This prohibition will be reinforced by annual notices and by prominent signs on district premises.

Community persons who violate this prohibition may have their permission to enter or come upon district premises summarily revoked by the administrator in charge of the property. School district staff are required to enforce this prohibition.

The board directs the superintendent to prepare appropriate regulations to implement this policy.
