

Distribution of Materials and Contacts with Students Promoted by Outside Agencies

The Yakima schools may communicate information from non-profit organizations to students that, in the opinion of the superintendent or principal, have social, recreational, or educational value to the students.

Students shall be encouraged to participate in the interpretation of Yakima educational programs to the community. The effect on students of such communication and participation shall be given paramount consideration.

1. At the building level:

- 1.1 Schools may communicate or distribute printed information through students regarding schools and school programs and also Associated Student Body (ASB) and Parent Teacher Association (PTA), Parent/Teacher/Student Association (PTSA) and booster activities.
- 1.2 Schools will assist communication of and be assisted by PTA, booster, and other school support organizations for activities which promote the aims and objectives of the school program.
- 1.3 Accredited institutions of higher learning may be permitted by the high school principal to provide information for students.

2. At the district/superintendent/designee level:

- 2.1 Schools will cooperate in community-sponsored activities and other non-school programs offered by non-profit organizations which offer scientific, artistic, sporting, cultural, or other community events open to the public, insofar as these activities promote the aims and objectives of the school program.

The superintendent shall establish procedures for the distribution of materials and information to students.
