

Public Performances

The board recognizes the scholastic and social value that may be derived from school sponsored groups participating or performing at community events.

Students may perform as a representative of the district or any school or other district organization subject to the approval of the principal. Permission and approval to perform as a representative of the school or district shall be contingent upon the principal's determination that such participation is in the best interest of the student, school, and district. Parent permission for a student to perform in a public performance will be obtained when, in the judgment of the principal, it is deemed appropriate.

While students may perform in traditional music events during the holiday seasons, a school-sponsored group shall not perform as part of a religious service.

Students shall not receive any personal remuneration for performing as representatives of the school or district.

The board directs the superintendent to prepare appropriate regulations to implement this policy.
