

Gifts to Staff

It is recognized that students and parents, upon special occasions, may wish to present a gift to a staff member as a gesture of appreciation. This appreciation can best be demonstrated by an appropriate letter of commendation. The board shall consider as always welcome, and in most circumstances more appropriate, the writing of letters to staff members expressing gratitude or appreciation.

Parents and students should be discouraged from giving gifts to school personnel. Any action or comment by any member of the school staff which might be interpreted as an invitation for a gift or favor is disapproved.

No school district employee is to receive any commission, expense-paid trip, or anything of value from individuals or companies selling equipment or materials to the district.

The board directs the superintendent to prepare appropriate regulations to implement this policy.
