

**Senior Citizen Recognition**

The board recognizes and appreciates the contributions which senior citizens have made to their community and schools throughout their lifetime. In recognition of these past contributions, the district may provide the following opportunities:

1. Residents aged sixty (60) and above may purchase lunches in school cafeterias at the price charged to staff of the district; and
2. Residents aged sixty-five (65) and above, who by reason of their low income would have difficulty in paying the admission fare to school-sponsored programs or athletic events, may be admitted at child/student-with-ASB prices. Special requests for no fee admittance must be approved through the district athletic director's office.

The board directs the superintendent to prepare appropriate regulations to implement this policy.
